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Aspiring principals

National Aspiring Principals Programme 2010
 The 2010 National Aspiring Principals Programme (NAPP) is designed to prepare aspirants for principalship in a range of New Zealand schools. There are 232 school leaders on this year's programme. The national curriculum for the programme has been developed from *Kiwi Leadership for Principals*.

Mentoring and coaching
 Effective leadership can be developed and enhanced through mentoring and coaching by a peer partner.

Aspiring leaders
 Aspiring leaders need opportunities for professional learning and encouragement to consider taking on the complex, but rewarding role of principal.

Succession planning
 The principal has a key role in guiding and supporting others to step up as leaders. Giving opportunities for others to lead is an important part of succession planning for the principal's role.
